Let's see what you've learned about Career Clusters. Place each of the following careers into the slice of pie (Career Clusters) where you believe it best fits. The description of each career should give you a clue as to where it might belong. Some careers actually fit into more than one Career Cluster. Geologist	A scientist who studies the history of the Earth and its life as it is recorded in rocks.
Photographer	One who takes pictures and sells them to earn a living.
Real estate salesperson	An individual who helps people buy and sell homes and land.
Flight attendant	A person who takes care of passengers' needs during an airplane flight.
Physical therapist	A person who treats injured or sick people by leading them through strengthening exercises.
Journalist	A writer who sells stories to a news medium, such as a newspaper or television show.
Financial planner	A person who advises businesses or individuals on how to invest their money.
Carpenter	A worker who builds or repairs wooden structures or their structural parts.
