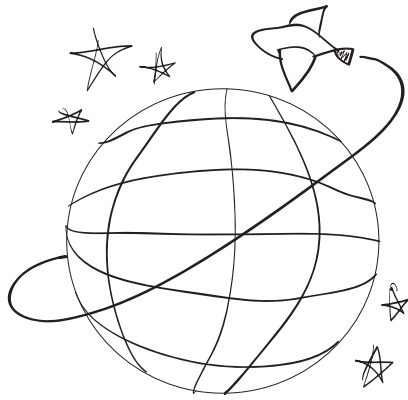
1. List the names of the three careers that most interest you right now.
